**RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Authority for Admission: Director Executive Founder President & Principal shall be the authority for granting admissions to Post Graduate courses in MAEER's MIT, Pune . However Head of Applied Mechanics Department MIT will be coordinator for admission P.G. Courses in Engineering.
2. Intake sanctioned by the competent authorities such as, AICTE, Govt. of Maharashtra, Pune University and Director of Technical Educations, Maharashtra, is as under.

3. **Eligibility:**

(a) (i) **For General Candidate** : A candidate may be permitted to register himself for M.E. degree by regular papers in the Subject under Faculty of Engineering of Pune University only if he holds a Bachelor's Degree in Engineering/Technology of Pune University in the respective branch or degree in respective branch from any other University, recognized as equivalent thereto by Pune University.

M.E. (Civil -Construction & Management) &  
M.E. (Civil-Structures)

:- BE/B.Tech.(Civil Engineering)

M.E. (Electronics – Digital Systems)

:- BE ( E & T/C )/B.E. Electronics

M.E. (Petroleum)

:- BE/B.Tech. in Petroleum/Polymer/Petrochemical/  
Chemical/Mechanical/Production/Automobile/Mining/  
Metallurgical Engineering.

M.E.(Polymer)

:- BE/B.Tech in Polymer/Plastic/Chemical Engineering.

**AND**

Candidate should have a valid GATE Score. However if sufficient GATE qualified candidates are not available, then Non-GATE candidates can be considered on the basis of his / her performance in Entrance test conducted at MIT - Pune. Fresh candidates appeared for B.E./B.Tech. final examination can also appear for entrance test but final eligibility will be decided after production of B.E. marks sheet.

**( b) For sponsored candidate, (Employed or work experienced candidates)**

i) They will have to appear for entrance test and should have first class in bachelor degree. The condition of minimum % marks may be waived in case of Teachers in Engineering Colleges or Polytechnics joined before 20-09-1990.

**AND**

ii) He/she must have 2 years full time work experience in registered firm/company /educational Institute. Non GATE candidate should have to appear for entrance test.

**4. ADMISSION PROCEDURE :-**

Admissions will be effected according to merit list prepared on the basis of valid GATE score in respective branch. Vacant seats due to non-availability of GATE candidates will be offered to non-GATE Candidates. A written test will be conducted for non GATE & sponsored candidates on **07-07-2009** from 11.30 am to 1.30 pm. The written test will be of 2 hrs duration carrying 70 marks. The portion for written test will be of BE/B.Tech. Standard. The students should bring calculator, IS Codes, writing material etc. with them. Seating arrangement will be displayed on notice board on the previous day of test.

**5. Interview will be conducted at the time of admissions. Interview, group discussion will be conducted on 08/07/2009 and 09/07/2009. A combined merit list based on maximum 200 marks will be prepared as follows-**

i) Entrance Test performance	:	Maximum 70 Marks
ii) Interview	:	Maximum 30 Marks.
iii) BE/B.Tech.	:	Maximum 100 Marks

**Total = Out of 200 Marks.**

- NOTE:-**
- i) Entrance test + Interview score and B.E. % will be taken into account to decide the merit of Non-GATE & Sponsored candidates.
  - ii) For valid GATE Score candidates in respective or allied branches, entrance test is not required and will be placed on top of the merit list.
  - iii) No reservation of seats for backward classes from sponsored candidates.

**6. M.E. Course is full time course.**

7. Candidate claiming to belong to backward class i.e. SC /ST will be required to produce a certificate to that effect from appropriate authority like Mamledar, or District Magistrate or Metropolitan Magistrate. Caste validity certificate from competent authority is also necessary.
8. Candidates belonging to SC or ST Category from any region of the country will be eligible for admission.
9. As soon as interview is over and if the candidate is selected for admission he/she has to deposit the fees in the Bank counter at M.I.T. Pune. Provisional admission will be confirmed only after the production of Chalan endorsed by bank.
10. Fees to be paid at the time of admission (for one year) is as follows

**11. OTHER CONDITIONS:**

1. The students coming from universities other than the University of Pune will be admitted on their producing the "Eligibility Certificate" from the Registrar, University of Pune. Admission will be confirmed in all such cases only after receipt of Transfer certificate form the college/institute previously attended by the candidate.
2. True copies of the certificates, duly certified by the Principal of the College last attended or by any Gazetted Officer need to be attached. Originals, if forwarded, may not be returned. The original certificate will have to be produced at the time of admission and whenever called for at a later stage.

3. No application will be considered which is not properly filled in or is not received in the office of the M.I.T.Pune, in time.
4. If any false information is furnished by any candidate, either knowingly or unknowingly, admission, if granted, will be cancelled and fees, if paid, will not be refunded.
5. If the candidate fails to report or remains absent for interview, on the prescribed date, his candidature will be cancelled.
